In accordance with the **Practice Direction** of Nov. 20/98, the trial judge will have conduct of all pretrial proceedings in this case. This includes interlocutory applications which will be scheduled before the trial judge by the Case Management Coordinator unless the trial judge otherwise directs.

We confirm our advice that the initial Case Management Conference (CMC) before the trial judge will proceed in **Vancouver, at 800 Smithe Street, on Tuesday, September 17, 2002 at 9:00 a.m.** The **Certification hearing will follow at 10:00 a.m. on September 17/02 and is expected to continue through Friday, September 20/02 (4 days).**
